

At Risk of Homelessness?

Santa Clara County Housing Authority offers an 'at risk of homelessness' preference for some of its units on the Property Voucher list. This means that if you qualify as an at risk of homeless household, you have a preference to be selected for a Property Voucher unit at the property. **Do you qualify as an at-risk-of-homeless household?** Answer the questions below to find out...

1. Are you in danger of losing your housing or missing a rent payment within the next 21 days?

NO- Stop here; you do not meet the definition of at-risk-of-homelessness.

YES- Proceed to Question 2.

NOT APPLICABLE- I do not live in a home where my name is on the lease. Proceed to Question 2.

2. Is the family's income **less** than that listed in the chart below based on the family size who will be living in the unit?

NO- Stop here; you do not meet the definition of at-risk-of-homelessness.

YES- Proceed to Question 3.

3. Do you have less than \$1,000 in your bank accounts?

NO- Stop here; you do not meet the definition of at-risk-of-homelessness.

YES- You meet the 'at risk of homeless' definition. You may answer Yes to this question on the Interest List.

NOT APPLICABLE- I do not have any bank accounts. You meet the 'at risk of homeless' definition. You may answer Yes to this question on the Interest List.
